# **6:35 Pandemic Task Force report**

Rick and Geoff

- 13 or14 people attended the meeting
- People were engaged
- Good start
- A lot of people are having a really hard time not getting to meet in person
- Spent time defining the purpose of the task force:
  - Make recommendations to the board about how and when we open and what that looks like
  - Sooner= who can stop by
  - Later= when can everyone go back
- Suzanne is putting her talents toward providing programming to promote connection remotely
  - Suzanne is joining up with Adult RE (so no need for a new committee or task force)

Next question lined up in original process: Do we have the right balance of workload for the minister and other staff? We didn't answer that question at this time.

- What does long-range planning look like? Re-evaluate how we deal with the Needs Assessment in the middle of a pandemic
  - Not anticipating SFUU will be growing at the same rate we were
  - Maybe postponing the process
  - What do we wait on (postpone) and what do we need to act on now (in the middle of a pandemic)?
  - Commission on Institutional Change (UUA)= changes suggested by the UUA

## 7:14 Vote to approve updated Letter of Agreement

The document circulated prior to the meeting contained the changes that Maureen, Nicole and AJ worked on- will update the small changes Gary suggested and vote again later. Other discussion at this meeting:

We don't need Minister(s)- plural

Section 223... Lead worship a minimum to 30 - 34 Sundays per year... isn't that just a minimum of 30

- If take maximum vacation then it could be 30- but if take less vacation time then could be in pulpit more of those Sundays (should be somewhere in that range)
- Not important to specify a maximum
- Not a big change so we approved without this change

Section 251- parentheses material might not need to be there - refers to an endnote so should keep it (therefore no change)

Maureen moves to approve the agreement Rick seconds Unanimous approval

- Restructuring going on

- Also looking at other fundraising and donations and legacy giving (restart this project)

#### Geoff-Adult RE

- Need a restructuring because 2 of their 4 members are gone
- Suzanne reached out to Jan because it seemed like logical place to get started with enriching, remote activities
  - Jan was thrilled to have the support- just she and George and Mary Lou Bailey and haven't met for a while- group was struggling
  - Jan sent a lot of info to Suzanne
  - In the works so far... at least a Women's group, a book club, popcorn theology
     (AJ)
- Suzanne wants to do a new survey because SO much has changed and needs are SO different- many more need to connect
  - Some people have a lot more time on their hands-- so maybe they would be willing to attend something like a 4-week course on "white fragility"
  - Needs are likely very different
- As part of the survey... maybe add "would you be interested in filling vacancies in these committees?"
  - Suzanne will just list the committee names and see if anyone is interested
  - Suzanne will send any names to the committee of interest
- AJ wants to be looped in to these conversations- wants to support
